



MineAfrica London 2007 Report

MineAfrica's inaugural **Investing in African Mining Seminar** in London, UK on November 19 was an overwhelming success with 135 international delegates and an average of 95 participants for each presentation.

The more technically focused **Seminar on Black Economic Empowerment in South Africa's Mining Industry** on November 20 drew 65 participants.

Both seminars were held at the Andaz Hotel (formerly the Great Eastern Hotel) - a five star hotel in the Hyatt family in central London.

Standard Bank, the bank with the largest footprint on the African continent was the premier sponsor for the two day event. Homeland Energy Corp., a private energy
