SEMINAR HIGHLIGHTS:

The main focus of this two-day seminar, after brief introductory topics, is a comprehensive review of today's and tomorrow's significant world class ore-bodies for all the metals (non-ferrous, precious, ferrous, alloy etc.); arranged by commodity groups. After a brief summary of economic and technological properties of metals, the emphasis will be on the geological characteristics where the deposits are, the mineral belts, how they were discovered, the mineral systems, field indicators, future prospective areas and global regions for their discoveries. The politico-economic and environmental constraints will also be included in the "Giant Deposits" case studies presented in the seminar. Moreover, characteristics of these deposits, how they can be recognized, traced and mapped in the field will be highlighted.

Between 60% and 90% of global metals supply comes from exceptionally large and world class deposits. Globalization has made much of the world accessible to exploration, property acquisitions and investments. Since exploration targeting is still heavily dependent on successful precedents and geologic models, familiarity with the most important modern mineralization types and their geological setting is essential for all mineral industry professionals.

This is a seminar detailing the site-visit account and the personal familiarity and experience of **Dr. Laznicka**, who has studied and visited some 4000 deposits in more than 85 countries. The seminar is aimed at mining and geology professionals & management, mining analysts, associates, investment bankers, traders and sales force focused in the resource sector, exploration practitioners, government policy makers, resource specialists, and investors.

Dr. Laznicka lives in Australia in Adelaide. He was born and raised in Prague. He has a BSc Honors from Charles University (Prague) and came to Canada as a graduate student. He received his MSc and PHD in EconGeol from the University of Manitoba (U Of M). He was a postdoc and then professor of U Of M until 1999 when he took early retirement to relocate to Australia with all his research material to establish "Data Metallogenica" at the Australian Mineral Foundation in Adelaide (industry-sponsored Amira project). Dr. Laznicka has authored seven technical books published internationally, has on-site experience for nearly 4,000 deposits in more than 85 countries and his publications are read in a number of foreign languages. He has consulted extensively for the resource industry and lectured at universities, geosurveys & in corporate boardrooms. Dr. Laznicka is a SEG Fellow, has honorary appointments at Prague and Adelaide Universities (formerly also at Heidelberg and UWA) and continues with professional activities to lecture key audiences on his knowledge of projects, mineral deposits and properties.
